#### Scenic and Technical Notes, Additional Technical Requirements

• **Trucks:** E-track, 25 ratchet straps, 10 load bars, and 30 blankets. TAO must approve the trucking company. <u>Rail shipment</u> <u>is not permitted</u>. Failure to provide proper trucking equipment will delay shipping of the production.

Scenery: 6 x 53' dry van Props and Costume combined: 1 x 45' dry van Props are equal to ½ a 53' dry van Video Wall: 1 x 53' dry van **Total Show, Full Production: 8 x 53' dry vans** 

#### • Flying:

- The production requires 35' to 40' tall legs for masking.
- Heaviest flown piece is the Bookcase at 3200#
  - TAO married two sets together and split the load.
  - Bookcase rigs to four(4) 3/16" picks.

- Motors:
- To do the show, a single 1T stacking/build motor is required
- TAO LX Plot utilized 16x 1/2T (could easily be 1/4T) for side lighting positions
- TAO productions use 5x motors and 12" truss for the two sets of US legs+travellers, due to the width and weight distribution with the panels full open.
- TAO Video wall hangs on 16" Tyler centerline truss under 7x 1T hoists.
- US Side masking can be done entirely through spotted hand lines.
- TAO preferred method is a temporary frame and motors to lift as a whole piece.
- Automation Lifts:
  - The TAO Ring Cycle set utilizes four(4) hydraulic scissor lifts. TAO may supply a US-based 120/208v Wye power distro. If adapting to other power, two control boxes require 110-230v 50/60 ac and each of the four lifts has a 5hp 230v 3-phrase 60hz pump.
- Man Lifts:
  - Hounding's hut requires at-height work. A drivable scissor lift is highly recommended.
  - The flown show portal requires at-height work to affix bolts at the frame hinges. A drivable scissor lift is highly recommended.
- 30 days' notice is required for all warehouse loading arrangements (including trucking, proof of insurance and remaining balances).
- A Technical Supervisor is required for load-in, and load-out; total working hours per day may not exceed 14 hours, including travel time. Technical Supervisor may not travel on workdays, unless it is agreed upon by both parties prior to travel arrangements being made.
- It is the responsibility of the renting company to provide a hang schedule.
- No tools are provided for loading in or loading out scenery. The Using Company is responsible for providing tools and/or ensuring that hands come properly prepared. Tools generally required: several screw guns (preferably 18 volt cordless), and basic hand tools. Alterations to the scenery are not permitted, unless authorized by Technical Supervisor.

Wardrobe Crew Requirements: 1 Wardrobe Supervisor, 1 Steward and 5 Dressers Wigs and Make up Crew Requirements: 1 Lead plus 3 Artists

#### **Additional Costume Requirements**

- A Costume Supervisor is required for pack-in, principal fittings, and pack-out; total working hours per day may not exceed 14 hours, including travel time. The Costume Supervisor may not travel on workdays, unless it is agreed upon by both parties prior to travel arrangements being made.
- The package does not include shoes or under garments.
- Patterns available upon request.
- Costumes may be altered to the extent required for fit, but in no way is fabric to be cut, painted or otherwise permanently
  altered without the prior written consent of TAO. A full list of alterations shall be provided with the return shipment. Please
  do not remove TAO labels from garments.
- Cleaning: Any pieces that are not marked Dry Cleaning (DC), can be washed and dried (either by machine or by hand/air) during the run. Dry cleaning expenses will be deducted from the Using Company's damage deposit.
- Costume pieces must be returned in the same boxes that were used in the original shipment and may be returned to TAO on the Scenery trucks.
